Continuing Education Requirements for Licensing

CONTRACTORS

Beginning with the 2009-2011 license renewal cycle for Utah contractors, required CE credits must be selected from courses on the DOPL online registry. Contractors are required to have six hours of continuing education, three of which must be in Core and the other three may be in either Professional or Core courses. DOPL approved courses cover a wide variety of topics for various contracting classifications, as well as the required core classes. Following completion of a course, CE Course Providers will upload attendance lists automatically to our system. Renewal will not be possible unless the CE requirement has been met. ELECTRICIANS

Licensed Electricians have a 16 hour CE requirement*, 12 of which must be Core hours and four may be either Core or Professional. Beginning with the 12/1/2010 renewal cycle, Electricians will also be required to fill their CE requirement with approved courses from the DOPL online system www.utah.gov/ce-public

PLUMBERS

Beginning with the 12/1/2010 renewal cycle, all licensed Plumbers will have a 12 hour CE requirement*. Eight of these hours must be Core courses and four may be either Core or Professional. Plumbers will be required to fill the CE requirement with approved courses from the DOPL online system www.utah.gov/ce-public

ELEVATOR MECHANICS

Beginning 12/1/2010, licensed elevator mechanics will have an 8* hour CE requirement. Elevator Mechanics will be required to take approved courses from the DOPL online system.

*CE credit may count toward both an individual and contractor's license if a course has been approved for both types of licenses. **PROVIDE BOTH LICENSE NUMBERS to your CE Provider!**

CONTINUING EDUCATION REGISTRY

- Lists all approved CE courses for Contractors, Electricians, Plumbers and Elevator Mechanics
- Provides detail and content of the courses available for ease in selecting topics
- Provides a Search feature to allow licensee to search by provider, topic (key words), license type, Core and Professional courses, and/or location for available courses
- Allows providers to upload CE hours taken by a licensee to multiple licenses for banking purposes; i.e, Plumber/Plumbing Contractor
- Allows a licensee access to his or her own CE information to view banked hours, courses taken, and if the CE requirement has been met for the current renewal cycle.
